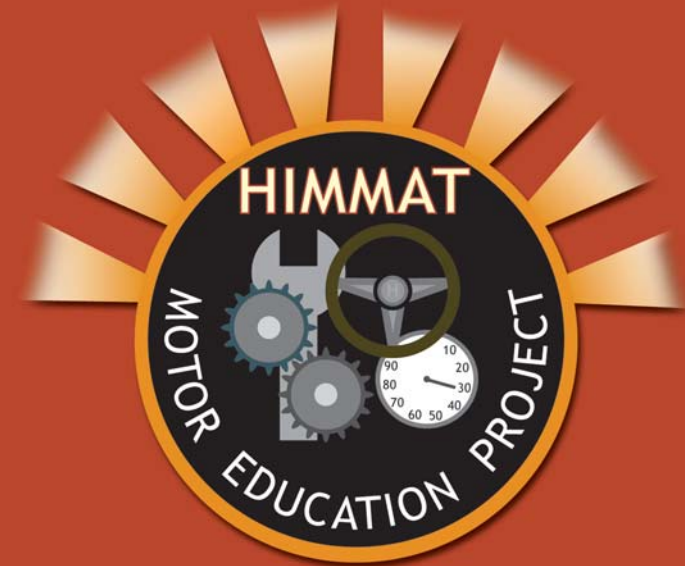

"Our aim is to promote and offer educational and vocational training opportunities to young people around motor vehicle activities."

The Himmat Motor Project aims to give young people the opportunity to maximise their opportunities in life - personal and professional.

The Project delivers **early intervention** in young people's lives so that difficulties in behaviour are not allowed to develop into later delinquency.

It offers a range of opportunities to capture the imagination of young people having difficulties in school and whose skills can be developed by the exploitation of their interest in motor vehicles.

Himmat operates a range of workshop activities to stimulate interest in learning, helping pupils retain their place in school or access other training opportunities so they are not lost to mainstream provision.

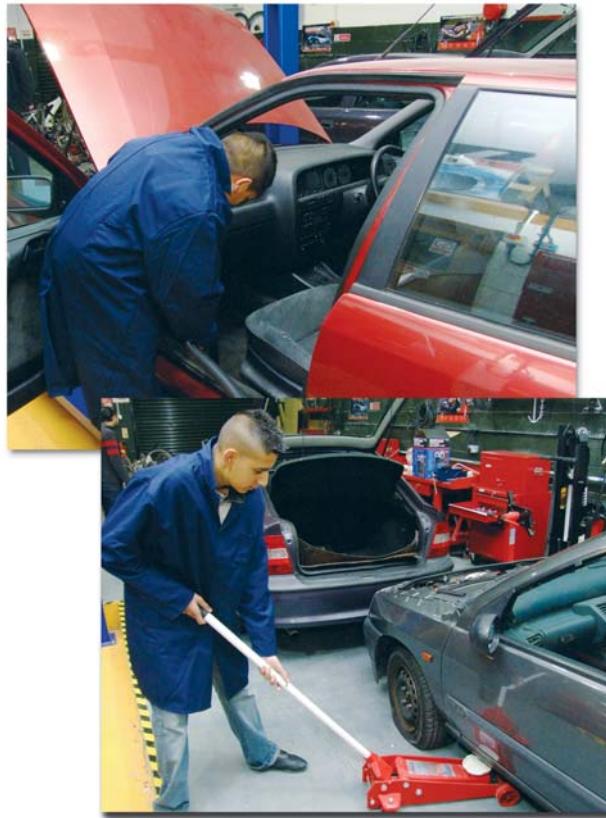
The Project is based in our new purpose built industry-standard workshop facility.

We offer:

- Day time provision to all schools in the area
- Basic servicing and quick fit skills
- Vehicle ownership, legalities and consequences of vehicle misuse

The project provides:

Who are the courses suitable for?

- Young people for whom 'traditional' learning is not appropriate
- Young people interested in motor vehicle and related vocational skills
- Young people wanting to increase their educational and employment opportunities
- Young people with little or no previous qualifications or opportunities
